TALK ON ARTS AND AESTHETICS OF TRANSLATION

REPORT

The Department of French, Tagore Government Arts and Science College organised a talk on Arts and Aesthetics of Translation on 19h February 2024 in Bharathiyar Conference Hall from 11-1 P.M. The resource persons of the event were Mr. Ari Gautier, the renowned francophone author of the novels *Carnet Secret de Lakshmi* (2015), *Le Thinnai* (2017) and *Nocturne Pondichéry* (2021) and Prof. Ajith Kanna, Professor of French at the Centre for French and Francophone Studies, Jawaharlal Nehru University, New Delhi.

Mr. Gautier's presentation titled the "Translation and Adaptation skills of literary translation" focussed on the language and cultural competence to translate literary works, drawing examples from his own novels translations into English, Norwegian and Tamil. He also discussed about the specificity of Tamil-French language used in his works and the challenges it poses to translators.

Prof. Ajith Kanna's talk titled "Translation is what translation does" focussed on the translation as a powerful linguistic and cultural activity which deals in the negotiation of finding the just equivalent between languages and cultures. His talk also highlighted the inefficiency of the Google Translation in translating the correct meaning from one language to another.

The HOD of the Department Dr. C. Annebaressou made the welcome address, Ms Bhawna Singhmar and Dr. Jenni Balasubramanian, Asst. Professors of French, were the event coordinators and Vishal Shankar, student of B.A IIIrd Year proposed the vote of thanks. The talk was attended by 40 students from Department of French TGASC, KMGIPSR, and of Pondicherry University. 2 Faculty members from KMGIPSR also attend the event.


