Tagore Government Arts and Science College having its Head Office at Lawspet, Puducherry hereinafter referred to as "TGASC" represented by its authorized signatory Dr Sasi Kanta Dash, Principal, which expression shall unless repugnant to the context and meaning thereof include its successors, administrators and permitted assignees).

Hereinafter individually referred to as CII or TGASC, as it may be, and collectively referred to as the Parties.

WHEREAS:

CII is a non-government, non-profit, industry led and industry managed organization, which works to create and an environment conducive to the growth of industries in India through advisory and consultative process CII charts change by working closely with Government on policy issues, interfacing with thought leaders, and enhancing efficiency, competitiveness and business opportunities through a range of specialized services and strategic global linkages. Young Indians (Yi) is an initiative and integral part of the CII formed with an objective of creating a platform for Young Indians to realize the dream of a developed nation. It has over 3000 direct members in 45 city chapters, and indirect membership of 19000 through its Yuva. "To become the Voice of Young Indian's Globally" being the vision of Yi, it reaches out to the global Indians wherever they are to make them an integral part of the Indian Growth Story. The Yi Yuva platform is one of the most active focus areas within Young Indians by which Yi members engage students from across the country in various initiatives that the students conceptualize, plan and execute. The objective is to create a bridge, a platform for the students to work in cross functional teams with a broad objective of enhancing their leadership skills and giving back to the nation. In the process, the students work in leadership roles while operationalizing projects that are based on self-development, skill building, community service and nation building.

WHEREAS:

This College was inaugurated by the then Commissioner of Puducherry, Shri S K Datla in July, 1961. It was started as a pre-university with a strength of 106 students. In 1962, B.A. Economics, B.A. French, B.Sc. Mathematics and B.Sc. Botany programmes were introduced. This College was upgraded to offer Post Graduate programmes in 1965.

Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru laid the foundation stone for the new campus in 1963 in commemoration of the Birth Centenary of our patron Sri. Rabindranath Tagore.

Tagore Government Arts and Science College is a co-education college. Girl students constitute almost half of the total strength. There are seventeen teaching departments covering almost all disciplines in Arts, Science, Commerce and Management. There are seventeen Undergraduate programmes leading to B.A., B.Sc., B.Com., and B.B.A. degrees. Tagore Government Arts and Science College is one the very few colleges in India offering French as an optional language to the students along with English, Tamil and Hindi.

Tagore Government Arts and Science College has 103 faculty members at present with the sanctioned strength of 135 faculty positions. This college has a healthy faculty: student ratio of 16:1. Of the 103 faculty, 55 have Ph.D. and 45 have M.Phil, degrees, Thirty are Associate Professors and seventy-three are Assistant Professors.

NOW THEREFORE, BOTH THE PARTIES HEREBY AGREE AS UNDER

ARTICLE I: Purpose and Objectives

Both the Parties, by way of this MOU express their commitment to collaborate with each other to:

- iv) Both the Parties understand and acknowledge that this MOU is a pre-requisite for further collaboration and cooperation activities, academic partnerships etc.
- v) Any other activities considered by both Parties to be potentially beneficial.

ARTICLE II: Financials

i) Both the Parties shall, depending on availability of funds and resources and after mutual consensus, dedicate funds for specific arrangements, academic projects and all endeavours envisioned under this MOU. Unless otherwise specifically agreed to in writing by the Parties, each Party will bear on their own the respective costs of carrying out the obligations under this MOU. Each party is responsible for its own taxes and compliances in respect to the deliverables envisaged herein and shall not hold the other party responsible for such taxes and compliances. This is merely a broad understanding between the parties in furtherance to the common intention for accomplishing the objectives mentioned herein above. In future, if the parties intend to enter into any financial arrangement, the legal rights and commercial obligations of the

parties as applicable shall be delineated through separate documents on case-to-case basis. Taxes if any will be charged extra and withholding tax if any will be deducted by respective party on any financial transaction as per applicable laws.

 Both the Parties shall be free to collaborate with and seek financial support, donations from national and international organizations, partners for cooperative activities to be undertaken under this MOU.

ARTICLE III: Coordination Between Facilitators

Both the Parties shall nominate one or more senior representative/officer, who shall be the point of contact/facilitator for the purposes of this MOU. The facilitators of both the Parties shall maintain regular contact with the other Party as well as propose and review different academic projects, programs and other activities in furtherance of objectives of the purpose and objectives envisioned under this MOU. The Facilitators may also be required to report to and coordinate with different committees or boards for the purposes of this MOU, as may be necessary.

ARTICLE IV: Intellectual Property Rights

Both the Parties shall:

- Share with each other all data, research and findings relating to activities, projects undertaken under this MOU.
- Enjoy joint ownership of all intellectual property rights in terms of copyrights, patents & trademarks for any discoveries, inventions research and any outcomes resulting from joint activities undertaken under this MOU.

ARTICLE V: Confidentiality

For the purposes of this MOU:

- either of the Parties who provides any sensitive or commercial information shall be referred to as 'Disclosing Party' and
- ii) either of the Parties, receiving such information shall be referred to as 'Recipient Party'.

The Recipient Party shall use the confidential information of the provided by the Disclosing Party solely in accordance with the provisions of this MOU and will not disclose or permit to be disclosed, the same, directly or indirectly, to any third party without the Disclosing Party's prior written consent.

The Recipient Party shall exercise all care and caution in protecting the confidential information provided by the Disclosing Party, from any unauthorized use and disclosure. However, neither party bears any responsibility for safeguarding information which:

- is publicly available.
- ii) obtained by the other party from third parties without restrictions on disclosure,
- iii) independently developed by the other party without reference to confidential
- iv) information, or
- required to be disclosed by order of a court or other law enforcement entity, provided written notice of such compelled disclosure before court or law enforcement entity is intimated to the Disclosing Party.

Language of Arbitration shall be English and place of Arbitration shall be New Delhi, India.
- Subject to the Arbitration Clause, the Courts competent jurisdiction at Delhi shall have exclusive jurisdiction in respect of all matters pertaining to this MOU.



This MOU details the scope of collaboration and the terms and conditions, intellectual property rights, responsibilities and obligations of SAS and TGASC.

2. Areas of Collaboration

The main objective is to partner and collaborate in all possible ways, in line with their respective mandates, and thus contribute towards a transformative change in the individual, the society and the country, leading to a better world.

The following joint activities and collaborative programmes will be taken up:-

- Conceptual, policy and action-based Research including impact assessments, case studies, etc.
- Jointly partnering and collaborating in projects and programs taken up in in association with the Central Government, State Governments, National and International Organizations.
- iii. Preparation of resource materials for various courses with special emphasis on Indian culture and values.
- Publish literature and develop print and non-print materials including original texts, commentaries and translations
- v. Organise seminars conferences and workshops, recognise degrees, diplomas and certificates of other educational bodies and institutions
- vi. Cooperate with any other association, society or institution having wholly or partly similar objectives as those of the institutions
- vii. Internships and volunteering opportunities for students
- viii. Undertake all such activities incidental, necessary or conducive to the attainment of all or any of the objectives of both the institutions.
- ix. Taking up any activity which leads/contributes to individual and social development and change.

The areas and fields for collaboration will be very wide and inclusive. There will be a special effort to draw inspiration from India's great intellectual tradition.

3. Project Based Collaborations

- 3.1. Both the parties from time to time may discuss and draw up theme-based collaboration in projects with a detailed implementable action plan, financial commitments, specified outputs, roles and responsibilities etc. Exchange of duly signed project, so drawn up, by both the parties will be deemed to have become part of this MOU and all covenants of this MOU will be applicable to such projects.
- 3.2. It shall be open for both the parties here to conduct research and academic exchange program in collaboration between themselves. However, such specific programs would further recessary negotiations, and working out of various aspects thereto inclusive of financials and signed by duly authorized signatories and shall also be duly approved by appropriate authorities of both the parties hereto.

4. Mutual Obligations

Both parties agree to undertake the following:

- 4.1. Maintain confidentiality as required by either party of their joint works until they are authorized to be shared by competent authorities in the public domain.
- 4.2. Maintain transparency in all its project related partnerships that may include supporting in reaching out to the constituency, gathering relevant data, sharing of available data and information and having a proper channel of communication.
- 4.3. Convene meetings at regular intervals to amicably sort out issues/disputes etc., if any.
- 4.4. Designate a key official/s from each party who will participate in meetings and facilitate all discussions between the Parties to ensure that the partnership is implemented as per the MOU.
- 4.5. The key professional staff/s of both the parties will be made available for interactions and discussions as and when required in mutual consultation and play an important role in the execution of mutually agreed assignments.
- 4.6. Both parties will enable the use of its expertise in training, research etc., and their respective infrastructure and pool funds for each assignment as per the mutually agreed terms.

5. Financing of Joint Activities

Irrespective of grants received, it is hereby agreed by both the parties that all the costs of respective bodies will be borne by them and that the said costs incurred shall not be claimed from one another. As far as joint financing activities are concerned, there will be prior understanding of how the expenses are to be borne by each of the parties hereto for carrying out such a joint activity. Wherever, necessary and possible, joint efforts may be made for raising funds for specific projects.

6. Relationship between parties

Neither SAS nor TGASC is or will be an agent or legal representative or partner of the other. Neither of them is or shall be responsible for the debts incurred by the other or be bound by any contracts or representations made by the other or any obligations undertaken by the other. Neither of them is or shall be an employee or franchisee of the other and nor does this MOU create a joint venture or any similar relationship between them unless and until specifically agreed upon and approved.

7. Amendments

The MOU may be amended by mutual consent through an exchange of correspondences between the two Parties. Any changes, modification, revisions or amendments to this MOU, which are mutually agreed upon by and between the Parties to this MOU, shall be incorporated by a written instrument, and become effective when executed and signed by both the Parties to the MOU.

8. Validity Period of The MOU

Expansion/modifications of its scope is to be undertaken through mutual discussions between the authorized officials of both Organizations. Such modification will be based on mutually acceptable terms and conditions.

9. Implementation Arrangement

In order to operationalize this MOU, the following implementation arrangement is proposed and agreed upon by the parties hereto:

- 9.1. Staff: Both Parties will identify their Staff/faculty who will be responsible for the assignment/ project / for coordination purposes and will meet as may be necessary in order to accomplish the purposes of this MOU.
- 9.2. Work Plan: A clear work plan would be shared with timelines, division of responsibilities and details specified for each joint assignment/ project.

- 9.4. Deliverables: The deliverables would be mutually agreed upon for each engagement/ projects separately by the Parties.

It is specifically agreed between the parties hereto that the present MOU, in no way restricts the parties from participating in similar activities or arrangements with other public/ private agencies, organizations, or individuals.

10. Dispute Resolution

Any dispute that may arise between the Parties hereto arising under and/or related to the present MOU or any other MOU's that may be signed by them in pursuance of this MOU on any specific project will be settled mutually between both the parties.

If the dispute remains unresolved for more than 15 days by mutual agreement then both Parties do hereby agree that any such claim, controversy, or other dispute between them relating to enforcement, implementation, interpretation of this Agreement or including the arbitrability of any dispute will be submitted to arbitration in accordance with the provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996.

The sole Arbitrator shall be appointed by mutual consensus of both the parties and if parties to this deed are not in a position to agree upon the Sole Arbitrator, the proceedings contemplated under the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 shall be followed.

The arbitration hearings, proceedings and all meetings held pursuant to this Clause shall be held in Puducherry, India and shall be conducted in English.

11. Intellectual Property Rights

In pursuance to this MOU, the Parties may produce documents, reports, studies, photographs, and maps, as well as documents as well as product-specific documents - tangible and intangible

information (collectively "Works"). Unless otherwise agreed to by the Parties, in writing, the copyright and other intellect u al property rights in any such Work will belong to both the parties jointly. The courses developed by SAS will be the intellectual property of SAS.

12. Effective Dates

The date on which the present MOU is signed and executed by the parties shall be effective date of commencement of the present MOU.

13. Schedules / Appendices

The works plan and schedules of each assignment, during the validity of the present MOU shall be deemed to be a part of the present MOU.

- 14.1. Either Party may in general terminate this MOU or any other MOU signed between them on specific projects by giving a notice of three months in writing. However, if any specific project undertaken by both parties, is by its very nature could not be shelved or dropped, abandoned or completed by either party without the participation of other party, then both parties shall be obligated to complete such projects. The term inability or otherwise of this MOU or any specific project can also be a subject matter of dispute between the parties which, in the event of being unresolved mutually, can be referred to arbitration.
- 14.2. There shall be no liability on the part of any Party to the other arising from the termination of this MOU provided that in case of this MOU coming to an end as aforesaid, the ongoing projects shall be completed as per the plan agreed to by SAS and TGASC and both Parties shall fulfil their respective obligations as part of this MOU.
- 14.3. This MOU is not binding on either of the Parties hereto, except as specifically set out hereto. This MOU is intended to express the broad understanding of the Parties and to provide a framework for working together on a specific opportunity as detailed herein subject to entering a definitive separate agreement(s).
- 14.4. Neither of the Parties shall at any time disclose to the third party any confidential information of the other Party, which is acquired pursuant to this agreement/MOU without prior written consent of the other Party.

15. Force Majeure

For the purposes of this MOU, "Force Majeure" means an event that is beyond the reasonable control of a Party, is not foreseeable, is unavoidable, and makes a Party's performance of its obligations hereunder impossible or so impractical as reasonably to be considered impossible under the circumstances, and subject to those requirements, includes, but is not limited to, war, riots, civil disorder, earthquake, fire, explosion, storm, flood or other adverse weather conditions, strikes, lockouts or other industrial action, confiscation or any other action by Government agencies. Force Majeure shall not include insufficient funds or failure to make any payment required.


