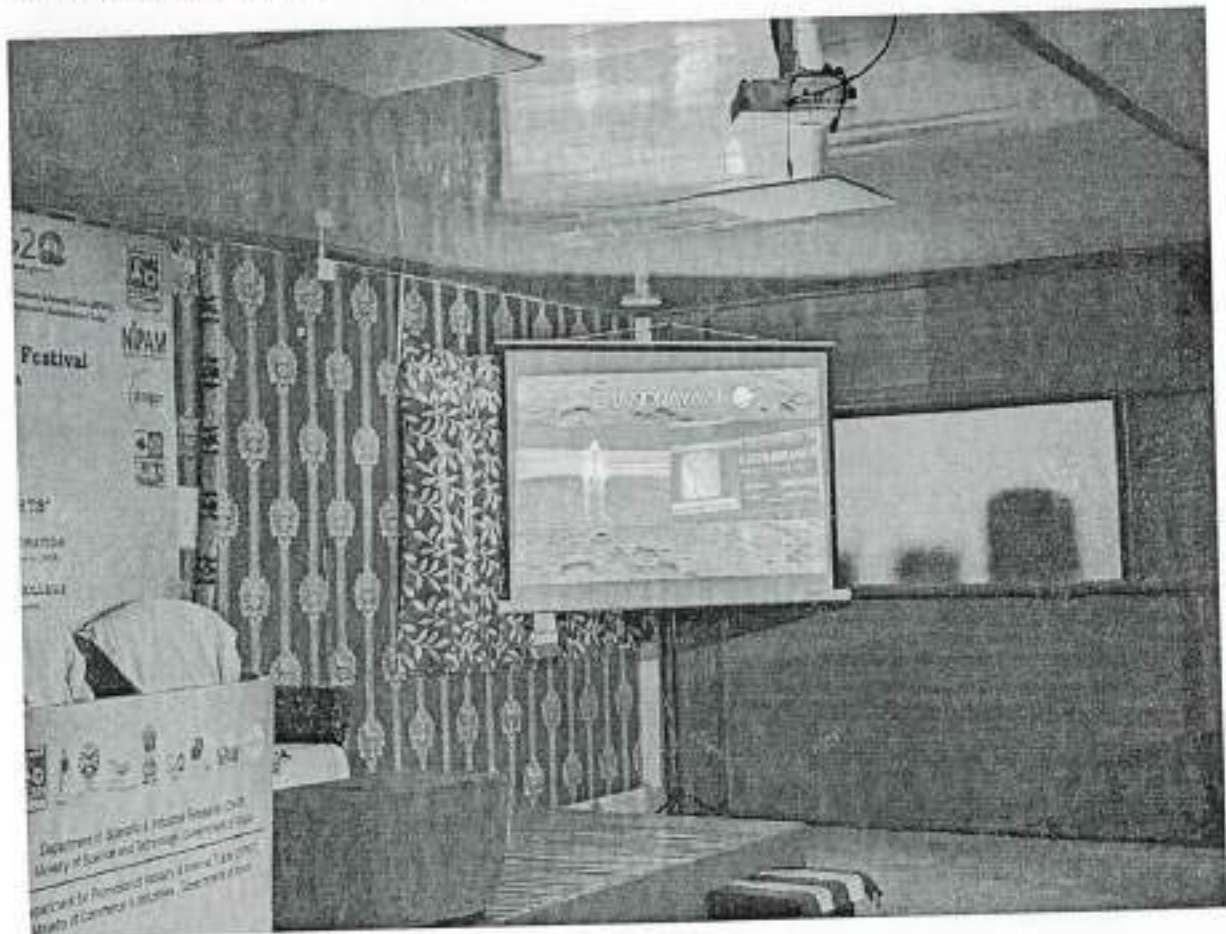
Astronomy Club, Activity Report

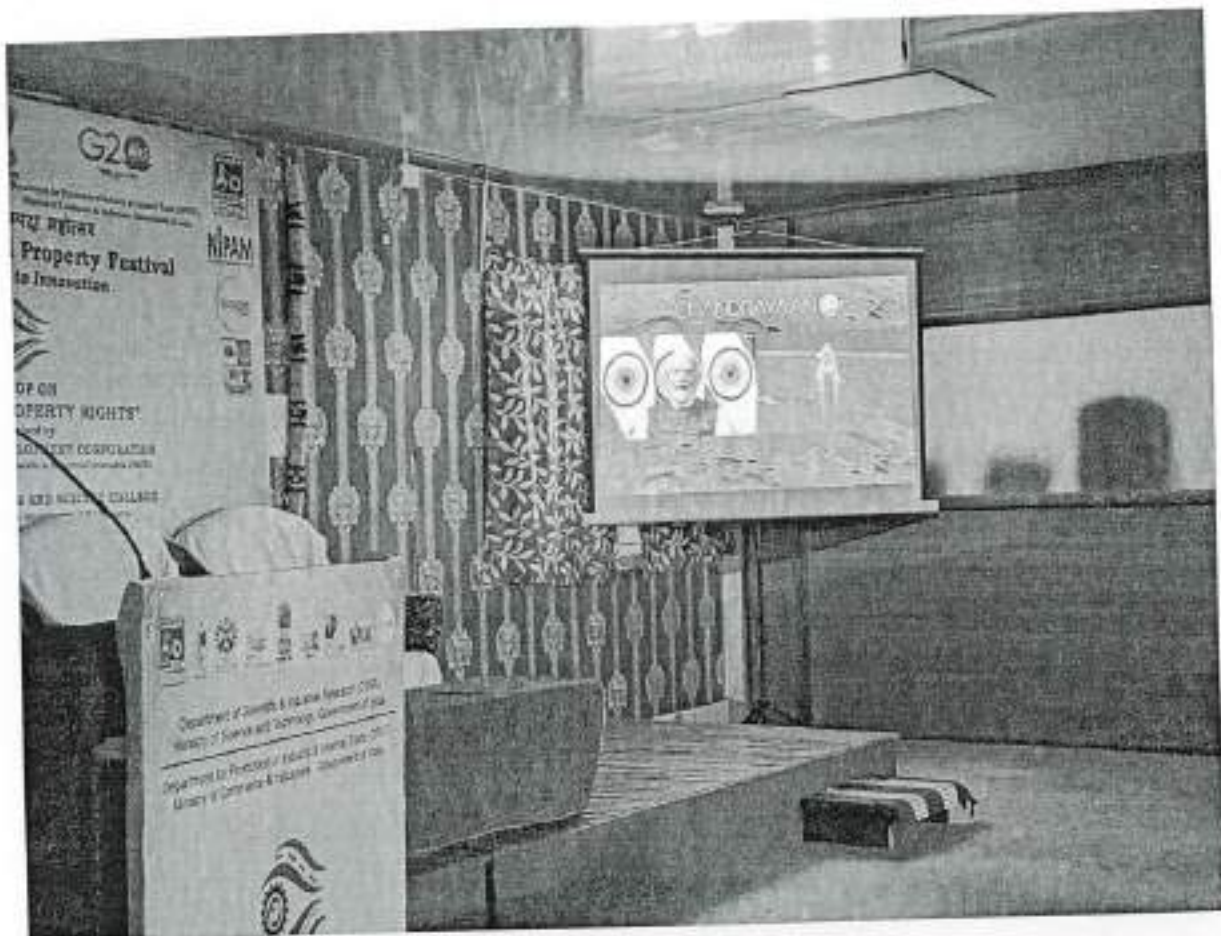

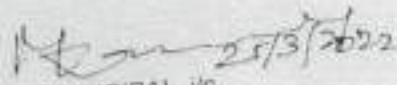

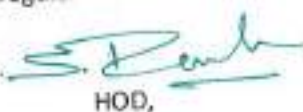

Summary of the one-day industrial visit by our Dept. students on March 13, 2020.

1. There are about 20 students 4, 5 and 11 students from I-, II- and III-year B.Sc. Botany respectively, visited **Pondicherry Biotech Private Limited** company at Pillaichavady, Puducherry on March 13, 2020.
2. It was organized and accompanied by **Dr. S. Vijayan Ph.D.** from our Department.
3. Proper permission received from our college with the letter of ref: No. 4-27/TGASC/Estt./A4/2018/345 and proceeded our visit.
4. Students learned many molecular techniques such as how to set up a PCR, how to set up a restriction enzyme reaction using a plasmid and electrophoresis analysis of the PCR and restriction digested product (Figure 1).
5. They learned the plant tissue culture techniques such as micropropagation of tobacco and rice plants. They also learned how to incubate and acclimatize the tissue culture grown plants.
6. They also visited their glass house and green house.
7. **Dr. Harikrishna Ph.D.**, working as a senior scientist, explained about the various activities and the routine work of the company. He also mentored the molecular biology techniques to our students. We thank him very much and his assistant **Mr. Prakash**.
8. We are very grateful to **Mr. S. Gunasegaran**, CEO of the company for providing a wonderful opportunity to visit his company. We also extend our thanks to their support staff for their assistance.
9. Overall, students are very happy and experienced new skills techniques apart from regular academic activities.

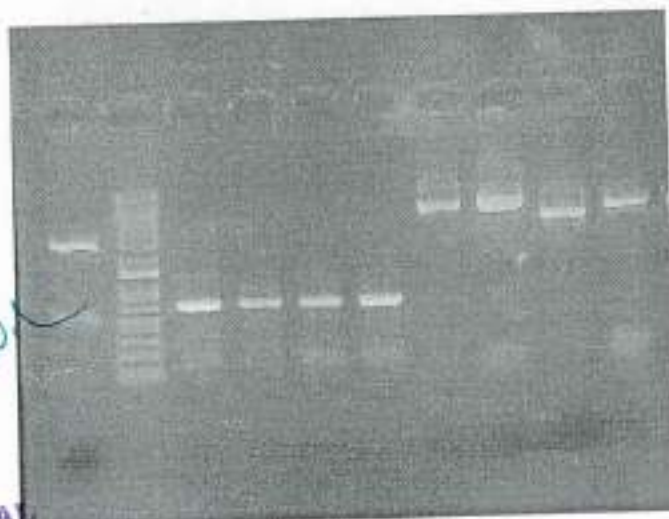

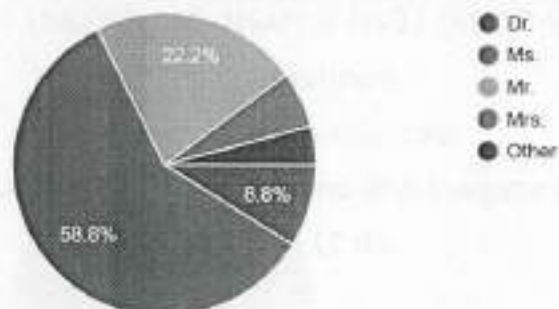

on 22.08.2020**

1. I would like to bring your kind notice the report on a National Level Botany Online Quiz 1 conducted by our department on 22.08.2020 (Saturday) between 10:00- 10:06 AM. The quiz covered the broad areas of Bacteria, Viruses, Algae, Fungi, Lichens, Bryophytes, Pteridophytes, Gymnosperms and Paleobotany.
2. With the motivation and support of our college Principal Dr.Sasikanta Dash an application for registering to participate in the above mentioned quiz through social media, emails, etc. was posted on 19.08.2020.
3. The quiz was coordinated by Dr.J.Rajamurugan (Assistant Professor of Botany) and Dr.S.Ramakrishnan (Assistant Profess of Botany and HOD).
4. An overwhelming response was received from students, research scholars and faculties across the country and the total number of registered participants was 813, which comprised 91 faculties, 48 research scholars and 674 students.
5. The Quiz contained 50 objective type questions and carried 56 marks. The questions were active only from 10:00 AM to 11:06 AM only (66 minutes).
6. Over four hundred (402) participants attended the quiz and submitted the form on time. The number of participants included 39 faculties, 24 research scholars and 339 students. The participants were from not only Botany discipline but also, medicine, arts, etc.
7. The passing minimum for the quiz was set as 50% and 152 participants scored it and they were provided with system generated E-certificates through Email.
8. 160 school students had a participation and passed the quiz.
9. Feedback was received from 215 participants appreciating the quality of the questions asked and their usefulness.
10. More than half of the participants were women students (58.8%).

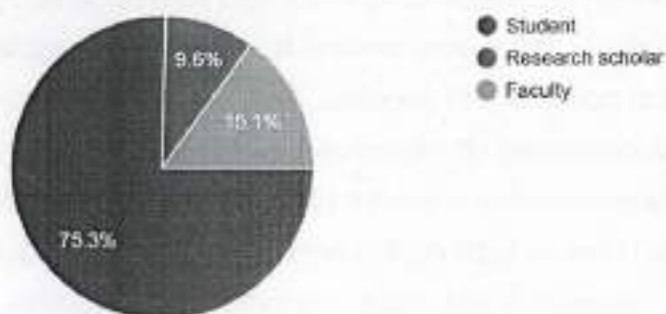

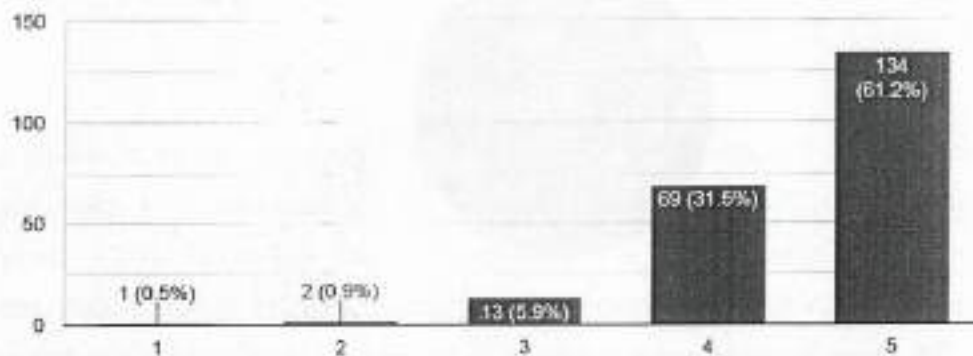

How do you rate the quality of the questions asked?

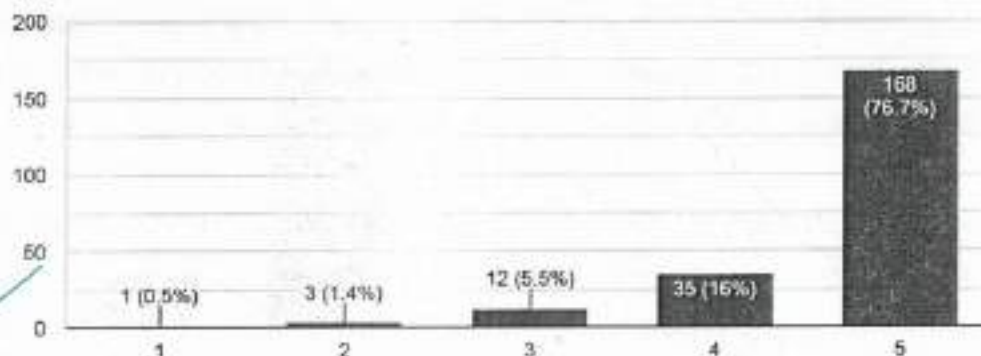

How useful was this Quiz?

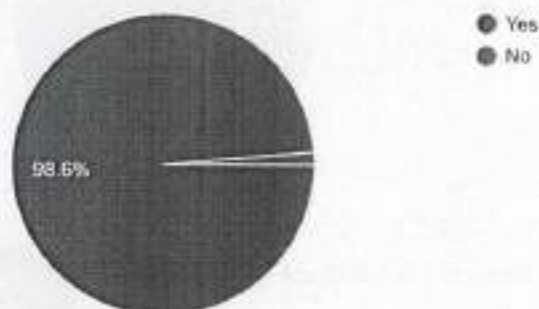

Disciplinary Rules and Regulations Taught to the Students

1. Students are expected to maintain the highest standard of behavior and discipline both inside and outside the College.
2. They must abide by the rules and regulations framed by the college from time to time.
3. Violation in any manner will be dealt with by the concerned Department and shall be referred to the Disciplinary Committee in necessary cases.
4. Students should be punctual in attending classes as per the time table given to them.
5. During class hours, students should not enter or leave the class without getting permission of the faculty.
6. Dress Code: Students should be decently dressed. Boys shall wear pants and shirts. Using T-shirts, jeans, tight pants, ear studs and improper hair style are not allowed. Girls shall wear churidars or half/full saree with proper hair style.
7. Mobile phones should never be used inside the class room.
8. Students should keep their class room clean and tidy always.
9. Students should fulfill the minimum required attendance of 75%, failing which shall not be allowed to appear for the Semester Examination.
10. Loitering and wasting time on the College campus and canteen causes indiscipline and must be avoided.
11. Students should park their vehicles only in the specified area.
12. Every student should wear an identity card issued by the College which should be produced whenever asked for.
13. Every class in-charge / tutor shall keep a close watch on the students' attendance, progress, and conduct of their wards.
14. WhatsApp groups with parents/guardians may be formed in every class and the names of absentees may be posted on regular basis with the help of class representatives.
15. Monthly attendance of students may be displayed in the department notice board and a copy be submitted to the office.
16. Discourtesy towards teachers, insubordination, obscenity in word and act, willful damage to College property, anti-social activities, etc are liable for disciplinary action including dismissal from the College.
