The following points were put forth by the faculty members

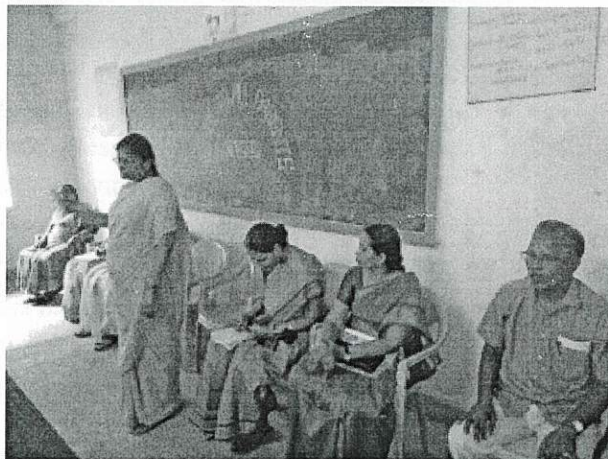
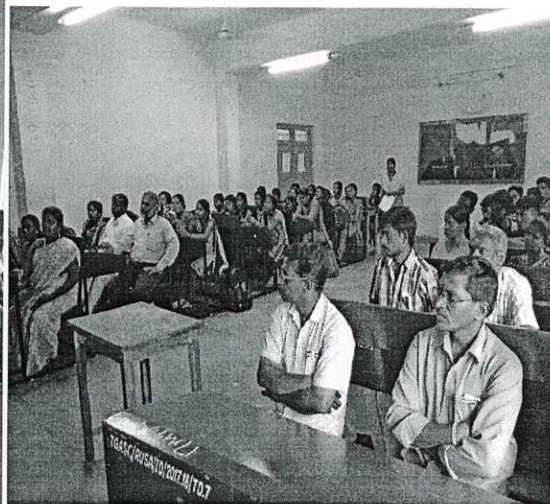
1. Students should abide by the rules and regulations of the college

Mentoring System Report for 2018-19

With the objectives of providing academic guidance and arranging for remedial measures for students a mentorship programme was launched from 2017-18 onwards. This novel idea was initiated and adopted by Department of Zoology with faculty as mentors in place.

Each student is advised to meet their mentors on regular basis to discuss their academic performance, any fears or personnel problems and seek feedback on the same. Being in a new environment away from house with academic pressures can be stressful for First year students. In order to overcome this kind of pressures and stress the entire students are divided into several groups under the faculties as mentors

The Parent teacher meeting was arranged for II & III year students during 3rd and 4th week of even and odd semester beginning. The following academic points were discussed with the parents in the presence of respective students. The students attendance of the respective semester and informed the students who have scored less than 75% and to compensate lack of attendance in the same semester.

The university marks of the previous semester scored by the students are shown to their parents. Marks secured in monthly tests for internal assessment and his participation is well informed to parents.

Third and Fourth PTM were held in 15.7.2019 and 13.2.2020 for the odd and even Semester. Out of 36 students on roll 34 students participated with parents. Students performance in the University examination are also appreciating trend noticed both in odd and even semesters.

No cases of Ragging, senior-junior problems, no gender discrimination reported so far in our Department during this academic year of 2018-19. Similarly poor performing students are given special attention in order to get through the examination. The pass percentage also yields good results.

Mentor System Register is maintained in the Department which includes all the details of meeting held and the matters were discussed.

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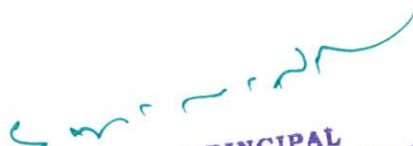

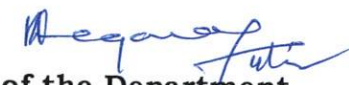
The university marks of the previous semester scored by the students are shown to their parents. Marks secured in monthly tests for internal assessment and his participation is well informed to parents.

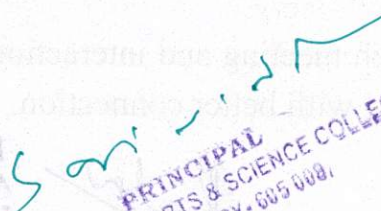
Report on Parents- Teachers Meet

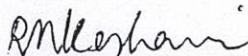
Parents-teachers Meetings were held on the following days

2. 03/03/2020- Parents of 14 students attended the meeting

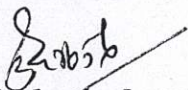
The parents voiced their worries about the future of their children. We counseled them about the methods they should adopt to overcome such fears.

The parents were happy that such a meeting was conducted and requested the teachers to have more such meetings. 93% of the parents attended the meeting.


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
