(Opportunities, Challenges, and Issues of the Prospective young Entrepreneurs)

CONCEPT NOTE

1. Preamble:

The individual entrepreneur detects or creates business opportunities that he or she then exploits through micro or small firms, by participating in funding the capital for that firm, carries out the role of a creator of the business project. Regardless of our definition of success, there are number of common characteristics that are shared by successful business people. Most of them are learned with practice and by developing a winning attitude, especially if he/she set goals and applies himself/herself through strategic planning to reach those goals in incremental stages.

To legally operate a vehicle on public roadways, one must have a driver's license; to excel in sports, one must train and practice; to retire comfortably, one must become an informed investor and actively invest for retirement. If his goal is success in business, then the formula is no different. There are certain musts that have to be fully developed, implemented and managed for his business to succeed. There are many business musts, but the following are some of the more important musts that are required to be a successful entrepreneur.

2. Concept of Entrepreneurship

Entrepreneurs are the people who are willing to take risks and who start and build successful businesses. The entrepreneurial instinct is the mental toughness that is required to make something from nothing. It is the mind-set that allows anyone to take smart risks, thrive in ambiguity and bounce back from failure. It is the reason why the team that looks good on paper does not always win and why the drop out becomes a billionaire. But, one thing is certain: becoming a successful entrepreneur is not easy. Therefore, personal characteristics, values, and beliefs play a vital role in the life of an entrepreneur. Typically, the mind-set of successful entrepreneurs should comprise the following requisites.

3. Requisites of Entrepreneur

- > **Optimism:** Optimism is truly an asset. It will help to get through the tough times that many entrepreneurs experience as they try to find a business model that works for them. Optimism is an art that need to be nurtured.
- ➤ **Vision:** When the entrepreneur sees in his mind the area for further improvement. He must quickly grasp the "big picture," and explain this to others. He must create a compelling vision of the future, and then inspire other people to engage to fulfil that vision in his head.

- > **Initiative:** He must be the one to initiate the start, or in a catchy way, it can be put as 'spark the rise' in the people around him to think outside the box and expand the horizons.
- ➤ **Desire for Control:** Being in charge and making decisions are Inevitable. The entrepreneurs must be motivated to lead others to that goal.
- ➤ Drive and Persistence: The entrepreneurs will encounter bumps in the road. He may lose big customers. Good employees may leave the company, and some may even become competitors. The government will change regulations, usually making things more complex. To succeed, he will have to be willing to persist through difficult times. Nothing can take the place of persistence and cannot succeed without it.
- ➤ **Risk Tolerance:** Understanding the physiology that drives motivation can go a long way in helping anyone become a better risk-taker. The key to taking risky bets is learning how to turn off the fear to light up the reward focus learning and pleasure motivated.

4. Interpersonal Skills

As successful entrepreneurs, one who have to work closely with people – this is where it is critical to be able to build great relationships with the team, customers, suppliers, shareholders, investors, and more. Some people are more gifted in this area than others, but, fortunately, can learn and improve these skills. The interpersonal skills which the entrepreneurs will need include:

- ➤ **Leadership and Motivation**: he should lead and motivate others to follow him and deliver his vision. Delegating work to others is essential because as a successful entrepreneur, will have to depend on others to get beyond a very early stage in his business there's just too much to do all on his own!
- > **Communication Skills:** he needs to be able to communicate well to sell his vision of the future to investors, potential clients, team members, and more.
- ➤ **Listening:** listening to what others are telling helps in analysing his actions. His ability to listen can make or break him as an entrepreneur. Make sure that he is skilled at active listening and empathetic listening .
- ➤ **Personal Relations:** To be emotionally intelligent means that he should be able to identify emotionally with the people around him and that should be able to feel what they are feeling, instead of standing detached. The higher his EI(emotional intelligence), the easier it will be for him to work with others. The good news is that he can improve his emotional intelligence.

5. Creative Thinking Skills

As an entrepreneur, he also needs to come up with fresh ideas, and make good decisions about opportunities and potential projects. Many people think that entrepreneurs are either born creative or not. However, creativity is a skill that he can develop if he invests the time and effort.

- > Creative Thinking: seeing situations from a variety of perspectives and coming up with original ideas to improve, and solve them defines an entrepreneur.
- > **Problem Solving:** he must be smart and quick at coming up with sound solutions to the problems he is facing.
- > Recognizing Opportunities: Recognising potential opportunities in the mist of problems or situations, gives him the lead.

6. Practical Skills

The entrepreneurs also need the practical skills and knowledge needed to produce goods or services effectively, and run a company.

- > Goal Setting: goals are deadlines without the force on the employees but still encourage and motivate others to accomplish tasks within a given amount of time.
- > Planning and Organizing: Dedicating time to simply dreaming about what he wants for his business is his vision for it. He sets goals, and then develops an actionable plan to make them a reality.
- > Decision Making: He must be good in making decisions. It is often essential as an entrepreneur to put others to think and decide important matters with caution and responsibility. They must be made based on relevant information and by weighing the potential consequences. He needs to be sure and confident of his situation.
- > **Negotiation:** he ought to be a good negotiator. Not only does he need to negotiate keen prices, he should also be able to resolve differences between people in a positive, mutually beneficial way.
- **Ethics:** he deals with people based on respect, integrity, fairness, and truthfulness. he leads his business ethically.

7. Knowledge

An entrepreneur needs knowledge in several areas when starting or running a business.

- ➤ **Business knowledge**: He must have a good general knowledge of the main functional areas of a business (sales, marketing, finance, and operations), and must be able to operate or manage others in these areas with a reasonable degree of competence.
- ➤ Entrepreneurial knowledge: he must understand how entrepreneurs raise capital. He must understand the amount of experimentation and hard work that may be needed to find a business strategy that works for him.
- ➤ Opportunity-specific knowledge: He must understand the market that he is attempting to enter, and he must know what he needs to do to bring his product or service successfully to the market.

- ➤ Venture-specific knowledge: An entrepreneur must know what he needs to do to make his business a successful one. And he must understand the specifics of the business that he wants to start.
- Finance; to run a successful business, he should have a decent understanding of finances, profit margins, cash flow and funding. The more comfortable he is with all of these numbers, the more confident he will be, and the better decisions he will make.

8. Conclusion

The famous inspirational quote states that, "When going gets tough, the tough get going" is the mantra for the robust, determined young entrepreneurs.

Running a business is not for everyone's cup of coffee. Whatever the choice, one should make sure that it feels right. Instinct is universal; it does not care where we come from but, it really matters that how best the potential entrepreneur understand the environment and other factors of production. If an entrepreneur wants to start a business, it is essential to learn the specific skills and also require a technical or technological expertise in key areas such as *creativity*, the *ability to keep going in the face of hardship*, and the *social skills needed to build great teams*.
