REPORT ON THE LECTURE PROGRAMME

“AUROVILLE: THE MOTHER’S INNOVATION FOR MAKING ENVIRONMENT FOR MANKIND AND ITS RELATIONSHIP WITH THE INDIA’S PRESIDENCY OF G20”

On the concluding day of World Environment Day celebrations on 7th June, **Dr. Jayanti S Ravi, IAS., Secretary, Auroville Foundation** delivered a lecture on “Auroville: Mother’s Innovation for making environment mankind and its relationship with the India’s presidency of G20,” after making a green walk in the urban forest of the College and planting tree saplings. The resource person is known as a scientist, Civil Servant, Writer, Speaker, Singer, Teacher, and Thinker.

The lecture enlightened the participants how the Auroville, a city (environment) that belongs to humanity as a whole have emerged out of the innovation of the Mother have transformed the society and environment. Similarly, how the saints and sages of India have helped in transformation of India by quoting Swami Vivekananda and Sri Aurabindo as examples.

The information shared by the speaker that the auroville foundation has brought out over 700 products so far because of its innovative initiatives and these products are unique in quality and fulfils the human needs and the foundation also opens skill enhancement avenues, are inspirational to the participants in their mission of becoming innovators.

Further said that the India’s leadership in G20 as a remarkable achievement and proud moment of every Indian and for such achievements innovative environments are essential in India. Mother’s mission of the Auroville, emerged out of the innovation of the Mother is not for a particular section of people or a country and it is for the humanity as a whole in the earth. Auroville is a universal township in the making for a population of up to 50,000 people from around the world. At present, in this international city 2500 people representing 59 nations from all age groups, social classes, backgrounds and cultures representing humanity as a whole is residing in a sylvan environment and this is what the **theme of India’s G20 Presidency - “Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam” or “One Earth · One Family · One Future”** also emphasises.

Finally, the participants had an interaction to clarify their doubts, especially for supports from the foundation for innovation initiatives and skill development. Possibilities for an MOU between these two institutions were also discussed during this programme.

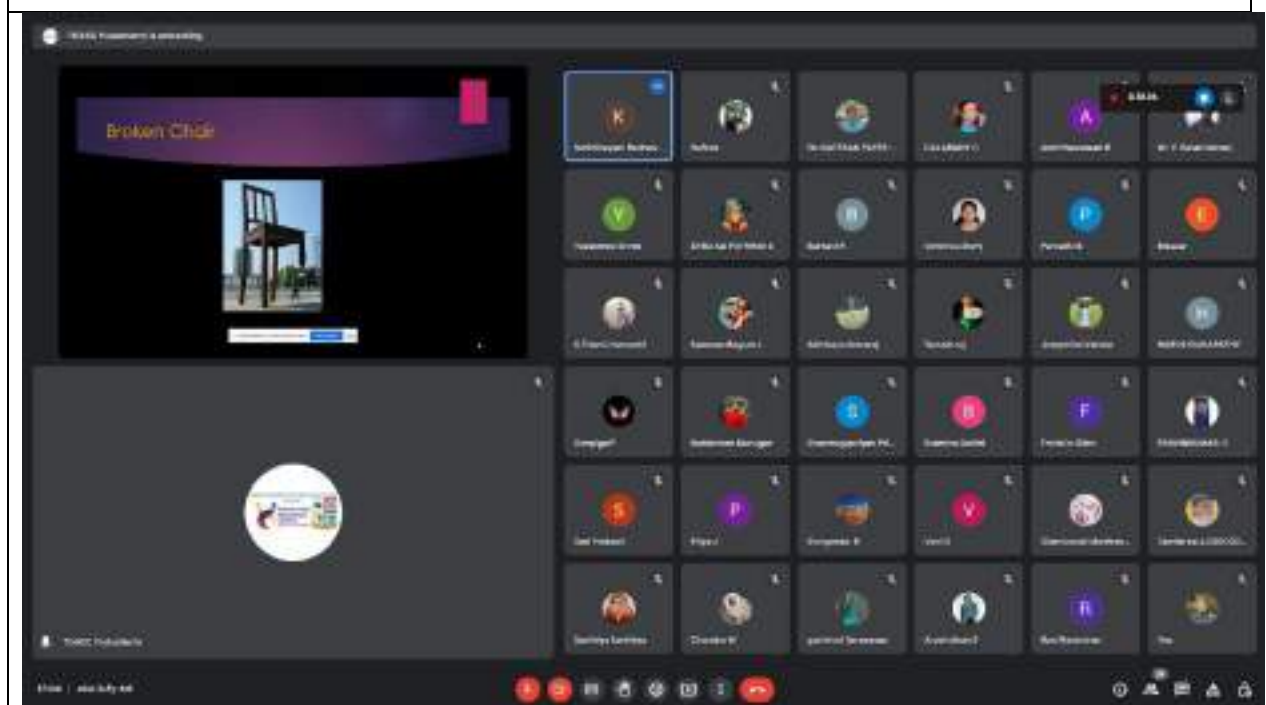
