COLLEGE DAY ANNUAL REPORT - 2010

Distinguished Scholar and chief guest of this evening Prof. D. Sambandham, learned colleagues, dear parents, my dear student friends and members of the media,

I deem it my privilege and honour to present before this gathering the Annual Report for the academic year 2009 - 2010 on the achievements of the students and the staff of this college during the 49th College Day Celebrations of Tagore Arts College, Puducherry.

This college offers 17 undergraduate courses and as on date 1712 students are on the rolls of the college, of whom 281 are girl students. There are 139 Assistant / Associate Professors in the college, out of whom 42 are Ph.D. holders and 70 are M. Phil degree holders. Many are currently doing Part - Time doctoral research.

Regarding the creative and research activities of the members of the faculty, I am delighted to inform you that Dr. P. Raja, Associate Professor of English, was honoured with 'Excellence in Literature' Award by the Government of Puducherry. The award was presented to him by the former Lt. Governor. As a council member of the English Executive Board of Sahitya Akademi, New Delhi, Dr. Raja participated in several National and International seminars and conferences in several states of our country.

Dr. A. Durairangam, HOD of Philosophy, discovered and deciphered a stone inscription at Eraiyur village.

Dr. Martin Selvaraj was honoured with a first prize by the Directorate of Health and Family welfare for the highest blood donation of Sociology students. He presented also a paper in the national seminar held at Tamilnadu Physical Education and Sports University.

Dr. A. Krishnan from the Tamil Department was honoured with the 'Best Creative writer' award by a daily newspaper *Dinamalar*.

Dr. N. Vajravelu and Dr. M.E. Krishnakumar, both from the Tamil Department, have published a book each in Tamil.

Mrs. S. Chindamany was honoured with 'Tamil Sudar - Special Award' for the paper she presented in the 7th world Historical Tamil Research Conference at ADM Women's College, Nagapattinam. Let their tribe increase.

Dr. (Lt. Cdr) G. Shanmugasundaram of Commerce Department got a financial assistance of Rs. 3,71,000/= from the ICSSR, New Delhi for his major research project and he attended two international and two national conferences.

Dr. R. Rajavelu presented papers at the Inter-national Seminar and UGC National Seminar, conducted by National College, Trichy and Sri Krishna College of Arts and Science, Kanchipuram respectively.

Dr. M.S. Ramesh and Mrs. Lily Arul Sharmila presented a paper each in the International conferences on Sri Aurobindo held at Pondicherry University.

Dr. S. Kalivarathan, Dr. T. Selvam, Dr. P. Kolandaisamy, Dr.A.Mani, Dr. M.E. Krishnakumar and Dr. Vel. Karthikeyan participated and presented papers in various Universities like Alagappa University, Karaikudi, Annamalai University, Chidambaram, Karpagam University, Coimbatore, and Pondicherry University, Puducherry.

Dr. V. Jayaraman presented a paper at a national Seminar conducted by Tagore Arts College.

Mr. R.K. Sharma presented a paper at V.I.T, Vellore.

Mr. N. Sivaraman presented a paper at Subramania Bharathi School of Tamil Language and Literature, Pondicherry University.

Mr. Gopal Sekar and Mr. A. Muthu Ganapathy Subramanian attended various international conferences and presented papers. They have also published as many as 14 research articles in various refereed journals. Mr. R. Varadarajan attended a National Conference at Pondicherry University.

Dr. K. Ramudu presented research papers in Seminars / conferences of National and International levels at Jawaharlal Nehru University and University of Hyderabad.

My joy is immense when I speak of six illustrious students who have brought gold medals to our college for standing first in their University examinations held in May 2009. The gold medalists are :

With the greater purpose of imparting knowledge to students from a plethora of sources, each department is blessed with an association empowered to conduct various programmes. The Department of Tamil arranged for Prof. Ma. Ra. Boopathy Endowment Lecture and Dr. N. Ilango, Associate Professor, Kanchi Mamunivar Centre for P.G. Studies delivered Special lecture on 'The World of Mass Media'. This Department also conducted a ten day workshop on 'Tolkappiam' in collaboration with the Central Institute of Classical Tamil, Chennai.

Dr. Francis Xavier from Bangalore gave an excellent talk on 'Memory Filing System' under the auspices of the English Forum. Rev. Father Antonisamy addressed the students of English and spoke on the art and science of sharing. The Department of Sociology organized a lecture on "Blood Donation Awareness" in collaboration with Pondicherry AIDS Control Society.

The Department of Physics had arranged for a lecture on 'Photonic Crystal Fibres' by Dr. V.V. Ravikanth Kumar, Associate Professor of Physics, Pondicherry University. Technical experts from Amaze Multimedia delivered Lectures on advanced software Technology and this is arranged by the Department of Computer Science. The Department of Economics organized a one day programme in traffic awareness and prevention of accident. A motivation talk on 'Yoga and Concentration' was delivered by Dr. Adinarayanan, a homeopathic doctor, to the students of economics. The Red Ribbon Club of TAC (Sponsored by the Pondicherry AIDS Control Society) not only arranged for a blood donation camp, but also held several competitions for students.

The N.C.C. Army wing functioning under Major K. Manoharan, the Naval Wing functioning under Lieutenant Commander G. Shanmugasundaram and the Air wing functioning under Flying officer R. Karuppasamy have done wonderful work. Our cadets performed guard of Honour to His Excellency Dr. Iqbal Sing, the Lt.Governor of Puducherry on the occasion of the conferring of Honorary Colonel to the Vice - Chancellor of Pondicherry University. SGT. K. Venkatachalapathy of II B.A. Economics and SGT. M. Jawahar of II. B.A. Tamil attended the prestigious Republic Day Camp

held at New Delhi in January 2010. Seven other cadets attended the National camp held at various places.

Our College has 2 NSS Units functioning under the programme officers Mr. G. Vedagamam, Assistant Professor of Tamil and Mr. R. Murugan, Assistant Professor of English. NSS volunteers of our units participated in many of the events conducted by the AIDS Control Society and donated blood in the Blood Donation camp conducted in our college.

The Student advisors are Dr. R. Jayanthi, (English) Mr. Sampath Kumar (Philosophy), Mr. D. Sivakumar (Economics), A. Noyaline (commerce) and Dr. Vel Karthikeyan (Tamil). Dr. K.S. Velmurugan H.O.D. of Economics is the convenor of the Disciplinary Committee and Dr. A. Durairangan, H.O.D. of Philosophy is the convenor of Students Welfare Committee.

The Career Counseling and Placement Cell of our college does excellent job and here is ample proof for that. Four of our students from III B.Com were placed in INFOSYS. Fifty of our students have got ISBR scholarships ranging from Rs. 30,000 to Rs. 2,50,000 to pursue M.B.A. This cell, started with UGC assistance, has a coaching programme for entry into services. Career awareness programmes in the fields of animation, logistics, management and e- publishing were conducted during the Academic year.

Our college Library has a mammoth collection of 89,000 volumes of books on its accession. It serves over 2000 students and 300 academic and administrative staff of the college. During the academic year 2009 - 2010, the library added 1194 books to its collection, spending Rs. 2,52,800 and circulated 32,000 books among the students and the staff.

Our students took active participation in the various inter-collegiate and inter-university tournaments and games and won laurels for themselves and for the college. There are several sportsmen among students of our college.

Fete de TAC 2010 was celebrated from 05.04.2010 to 07.04.2010. Various competitions like Essay writing, Poetry writing and Elocution in English, Tamil and French, Poster Making, clay Modeling, Rangoli and Kolam, Light Music, Mono - Acting, Group Dance, Solo Dance and Quiz were conducted. A large number of students participated in all the competitions with great enthusiasm. Dr. R. Rajavelu, Associate Professor of English, acted as the co-ordinator for all these competitions.

Let me make use of this opportunity to express my wholehearted thanks to our chief guest Prof. D. Sambadham. To run this institution without the co-operation of the teaching staff, the students and the non-teaching staff, is to think of impossibility. I thank them all profusely. Let me record here also of my gratitude to the government, the Secretary of Education, the Joint Secretary and the Director of Higher and Technical Education for their unstinted support in the administration of the college.

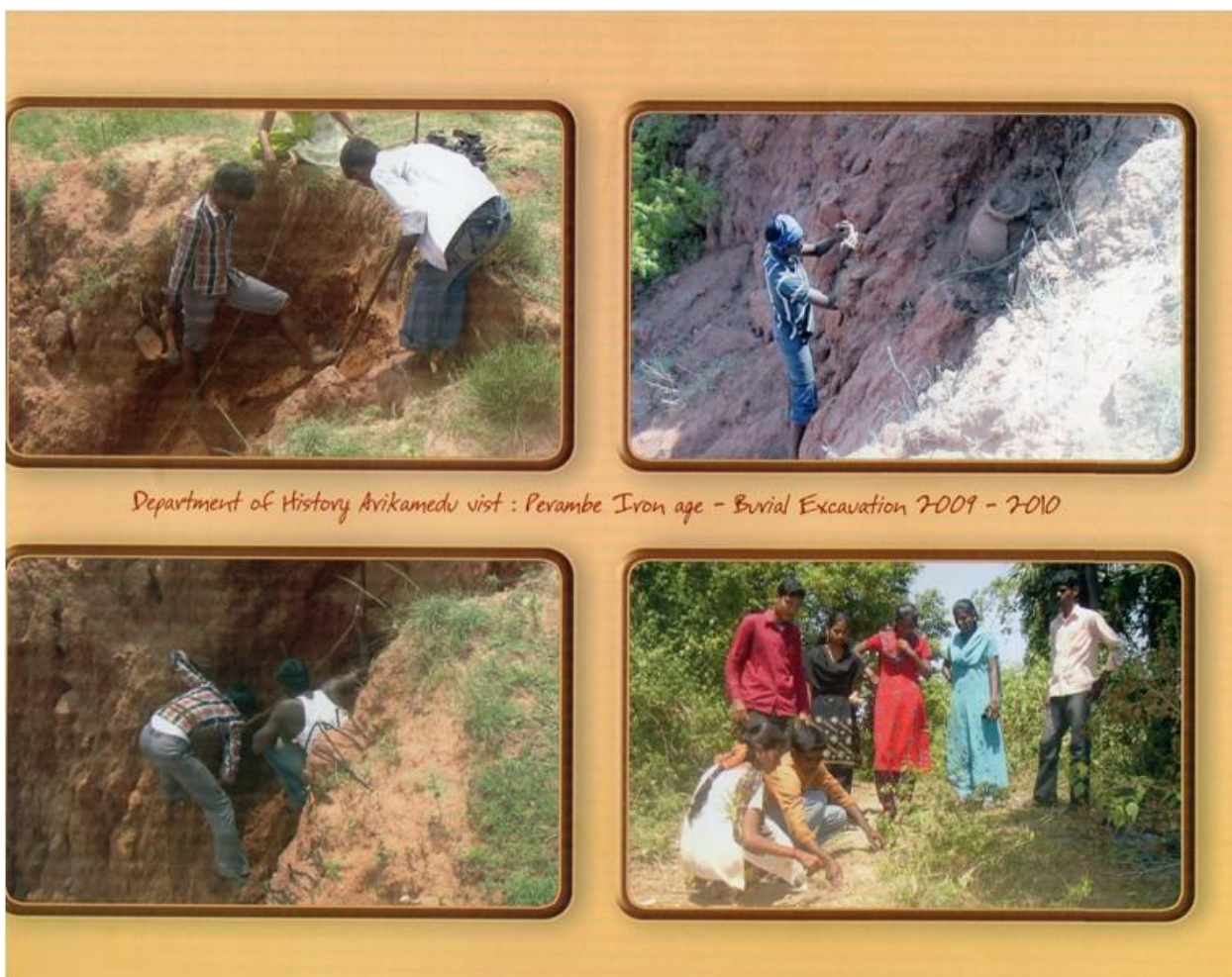
